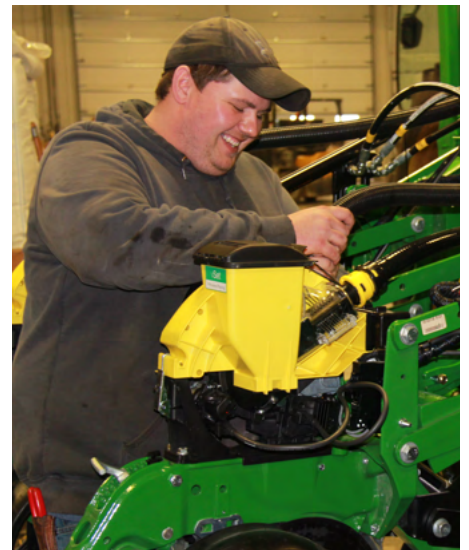

A March 2023 start date is preferred. Past agronomy or crop scouting experience is helpful. You do not need to have past precision ag experience, but you must have a strong willingness to learn throughout the summer!
